BJE's professional team worked throughout the second half of the school year to help educators, parents and students navigate the ever-changing circumstances brought about by the pandemic. Your donation made BJE's ongoing work throughout the community possible, especially during this unprecedented and trying time. Among its activities:

BJE hosted **58 zoom-based professional development sessions** for early childhood, day school and part-time religious school teachers and administrators.

BJE's Reshet-LA introduced the BJE Religious Schools Network to Positive Education as an approach to providing support for students' wellness and mental health.

BJE's JKidLA website saw a 50% increase in visitors seeking information about virtual and home-based Jewish educational opportunities.

Through **BJE's day school affordability initiatives**, almost \$2 million were distributed to 14 day schools from the interest in their endowment funds and a match from the Simha and Sara Lainer Day School Endowment Fund.

BJE virtually hosted administrators from **28 day schools to learn how to maximize federal funding BJE secures** for its Consortium schools.

BJE celebrated 88 directors of early childhood programs, part-time Jewish schools and heads of day schools and yeshivot at its **2021 Gala**.

Two cohorts of BJE's virtual teen service learning program, L'Dor V'Dor: Digital Edition, were held. BJE partnered with the Holocaust Museum Los Angeles to pair high school students with isolated survivors and engage in group reflections about the impact of their experiences.
