PAA PILOT YEAR: 3rd thru 5th grade

Called to help launch a Performing Arts Academy at VBS.

First Show - JOSEPH AND THE AMAZING TECHNICOLOR DREAMCOAT Hebrew by grade level followed by

Performing Arts Dybukk Theater taught playwriting workshops

Second Show - "In the Brother's Defense,"

The Joseph story told from his brothers' perspective and written by students.

Strengths:

The project based learning model, attendance up, playwriting thru Torah Study

Areas for improvement:

3rd graders were too young, teaching Hebrew separately, focusing on one story in the Torah for a full year.
